She then went on to play for Culver Academy in Culver, IN where she played three seasons, sophomore through senior year. In addition to playing hockey, she was also a member of the Culver Girls Soccer Team, Softball Team, and Lacrosse Teams. She was a member of Culvers 2005 Sectional Champs for soccer and a member of the 2006 and 2007 Sectional Champs for Softball. Kelsea was a 4 year selection to the WAHA Girls' Development Camps and Central District Camps throughout her high school Career. In addition, she was selected to the 2003 Girls National 14/15 Player Development Camp in Rochester, New York and in 2006 to the Midwest Chicago Showcase and Minnesota Junior Showcase teams. After high school, Kelsea played her freshmen and sophomore seasons for Bethel University in St Paul, MN. She was a 2 year starter and played in 53 games as a forward and defenseman helping Bethel to consecutive MIAC playoff appearances.
